The following information and opportunities are for both boys and girls interested in playing golf at Fox High School next school year. This information is also on the Fox Summer Golf Google Classroom page. Students/aspiring golfers should join the classroom using the code above (e2x3wv) and Coach Boyd will email/invite parents/guardians once their child is in the Google Classroom.

First, the girls golf season begins on Monday August 6th. Girl golfers will need a completed physical on file with the athletic office prior to practice/tryouts. Forms and more information will be available on the Fox Golf website and are on the Fox Athletics website- <https://fhswarriors.com/> . There will soon be a date announced for school physicals in July which will take place at the high school. Check the Athletic website and the Summer Golf website for the specific date and time.

The boys' season begins late February/early March. There will be an announcement made over the school intercom in January about a preseason meeting. Follow @foxgolfcoach on Twitter for information, and see Coach Boyd in room 208 at Fox High School with any questions.

The Fox Golf program will be meeting throughout the summer for some mornings at the range and to play nine holes at Arnold Golf Club (formerly Pomme Creek Golf Course), the team's home course.

We will meet at the First Tee Driving Range on Lemay Ferry Rd. on the following dates...

Tuesday June 5th, 12th, 26th and July 17th & 24th. Each morning will last from 8am-9:30am.

Golfers should bring money to purchase their own range card for the summer. Pricing for range cards can be found at their website- <http://thefirstteerange.com/>

The first time we'll meet at the range is Tuesday June 5th. It would be great if everyone came out for one of the first range dates and we could get to know everyone.

We will also be meeting at our home course, Arnold Golf Club on the following dates...

Thursday June 7th, 14th, 28th and July 19th, 26th. Each morning will last from 8am-10:30am.

Golfers will need to bring \$8 for the Fox golfer rate to walk nine holes. Pay at the clubhouse then meet near the first tee box at 8:00am on June 7th. Practice will be over around 10:30am. Don't worry if you haven't golfed a lot in the past. The playing formats will be fun and instructional.

Any changes/cancellations to the scheduled dates due to weather or other circumstances will be posted to the Summer Golf Google Classroom webpage and on Twitter @foxgolfcoach

There will be other opportunities throughout the summer to play golf with Fox coaches and returning members. Often, plans are made to meet up at a local course to play 18 holes on Friday mornings. Boys assistant coach Scott Neibert will often coordinate outings with returning golfers, and new golfers to the program are welcome to join in. Area courses usually accommodate our high school golfers with discounted rates. Plans are usually made on Tuesdays at the range to make tee times for the upcoming

Friday. We will also put the info on Google Classroom and Twitter as well. We will share contact/text information during our first range and Pomme sessions so that everyone can be kept “in the loop”.

For those experienced golfers and golfers returning to the program, consideration should be made to play in Gateway Jr. PGA tournaments and Accelerated Golf Tour tournaments.
